HOUSE BILL NO. 38

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR SOCIAL WORKERS AND MARRIAGE AND FAMILY 4 THERAPISTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 6 7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in 8 the State Treasury to the credit of the Board of Examiners for 9 Social Workers and Marriage and Family Therapists for the purpose 10 of defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 11 12\$ 326,151.00. SECTION 2. 33 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 34 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 35 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 37 38 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 39 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 42 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 45 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 46 47 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 48 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 49 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 50 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 51 52 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 53 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 54 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

55 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 56 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 57 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 58 59 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 60 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 61 *HR05/A821*

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

68 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 69 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 70 71 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 72 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 73 74 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 75 76 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 77 78 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 79 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 80 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 81 82 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 83 authorized in this act.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 84 85 Board of Examiners for Social Workers and Marriage and Family 86 Therapists shall maintain complete accounting and personnel 87 records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under 88 this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. 89 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request 90 for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative 91 92 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 93 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 94 budget request process.

Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Nine 96 Thousand Sixteen Dollars (\$9,016.00) is hereby assessed on any 97 non-federal special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget 98 Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code 99 of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of 100 reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

101 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 102 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 103 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 104 105 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 106 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 107 108 and after July 1, 2005.
