HOUSE BILL NO. 39

AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE

PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD

3 OF PSYCHOLOGY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of 7 8 Psychology, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending 9 10 June 30, 2006.....\$ 103,668.00. SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 11 12 Mississippi State Board of Psychology shall maintain complete 13 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 14 15 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 16 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 17 18 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 19 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 20 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 21 SECTION 3. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Three 22 Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-eight Dollars (\$3,668.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited 23 to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, 24 Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the 25 26 purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative 27 costs.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 28 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 29 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 30 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 31 32 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 33 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after July 1, 2005. 35
