4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out
7	of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available
8	to the Yellow Creek State Inland Port Authority, for the purpose
9	of defraying the expenses of the Authority for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
11	\$ 6,723,558.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15	expenditure:

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
Yellow Creek State Inland Port Authority shall maintain complete
accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be
submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.
SECTION 4. None of the monies appropriated under this act
shall be expended for payment of that amount of the salary of any
person holding the position of division director, department
director or head, bureau director, deputy or assistant director or
similar position on May 15, 2005, which would exceed the amount
actually paid for the same position on June 30, 2003, regardless
of the title or position held or duties performed by the person
holding the position on June 30, 2003.
SECTION $\underline{5.}$ The money herein approved for expenditure shall
be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer
or officers, in the manner provided by law.
SECTION $\underline{6.}$ This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2005.
