5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPE		
6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
8	Treasury to the credit of the Veterans' Home Purchase Board's		
9	revolving fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the		
10	Veterans' Home Purchase Board and making new home loans as		
11	authorized by law for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and		
12	ending June 30, 2006\$ 31,	912,475.00.	
13	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
14	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be		
15	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

33	With the funds	herein appropriated, it is the inter	tion of
34	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to		
35	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal		
36	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006		
37	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions		
38	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the		
39	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the		
40	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall		
41	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all		
42	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this		
43	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure		
44	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual		annual
45	cost and/or the Fis	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal	
46	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.		
47	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal		
48	Services," the Stat	e Personnel Board determines that the	agency
49	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

- 67 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
- 69 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
- 70 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
- 71 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
- 72 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of
- 73 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
- 74 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
- 75 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
- 76 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as
- 77 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
- 78 of a departing employee with an individual from within state
- 79 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
- 80 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
- 81 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
- 82 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
- 83 authorized in this act.
- 84 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 85 Veterans' Home Purchase Board shall maintain complete accounting
- 86 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 87 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 88 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 89 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 90 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to
- 91 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 92 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 93 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the sum 94 of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), or so much thereof as 95 may be available, shall come from the issuance and sale of revenue 96 97 bonds authorized by Chapter 501, Laws of 1985. 98 **SECTION 5.** None of the monies appropriated under this act 99 shall be expended for payment of that amount of the salary of any person holding the position of division director, department 100 101 director or head, bureau director, deputy or assistant director or 102 similar position on May 15, 2005, which would exceed the amount actually paid for the same position on June 30, 2003, regardless 103 104 of the title or position held or duties performed by the person holding the position on June 30, 2003. 105 106 **SECTION** 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 107 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 108 109 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 110 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 111 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. **SECTION** 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 112

and after July 1, 2005.

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
