33	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of	
34	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to	
35	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal	
36	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006	
37	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions	
38	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the	
39	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the	
40	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall	
41	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all	
42	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this	
43	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure	
44	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual	
45	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal	
46	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.	
47	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal	
48	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency	
49	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this	
50	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services"	
51	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which

- 73 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
- 74 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
- 75 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
- 76 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as
- 77 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
- 78 of a departing employee with an individual from within state
- 79 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
- 80 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
- 81 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
- 82 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
- 83 authorized in this act.
- 84 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 85 Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification
- 86 Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records
- 87 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this
- 88 act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of
- 89 detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the
- 90 intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for
- 91 Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
- 92 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
- 93 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006
- 94 budget request process.

95	SECTION 4. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Thirteen
96	Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-three Dollars (\$13,653.00) is hereby
97	assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited
98	to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301,
99	Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the
100	purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative
101	costs.
102	<b>SECTION 5.</b> None of the monies appropriated under this act
103	shall be expended for payment of that amount of the salary of any
104	person holding the position of division director, department
105	director or head, bureau director, deputy or assistant director or
106	similar position on May 15, 2005, which would exceed the amount
107	actually paid for the same position on June 30, 2003, regardless
108	of the title or position held or duties performed by the person
109	holding the position on June 30, 2003.
110	<b>SECTION</b> $\underline{\underline{6.}}$ The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
111	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
112	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
113	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
114	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
115	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
