## HOUSE BILL NO. 57

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE 1 2 EXPENSES AND PROVIDING CONTINGENT FUNDS FOR THE LEGISLATURE, THE 3 EXPENSES OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE, THE EXPENSES 4 OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON PERFORMANCE EVALUATION AND EXPENDITURE REVIEW, THE EXPENSES OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE 5 б REAPPORTIONMENT COMMITTEE, THE EXPENSES OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON 7 COMPILATION, REVISION AND PUBLICATION OF LEGISLATION, PAYING THE MONTHLY EXPENSE ALLOWANCE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE, 8 PAYING THE STATE'S SHARE OF VARIOUS ASSESSMENTS, AND RELATED 9 10 PURPOSES, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 13 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying 14 salaries, mileage, insurance, matching funds and the daily expense 15 allowance of the members of the Legislature for the Regular 16 Session of 2006 and providing contingent funds for the House of 17 Representatives and Senate for the fiscal year beginning 18 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006, as follows: 19 20 For salaries, mileage, insurance, matching funds and daily 21 expense allowance of members 22 of the House of Representatives..... \$3,033,317.00 23 For Contingent Fund for the 24 House of Representatives ..... \$4,264,433.00 25 26 Out of the above amount appropriated for the Contingent Fund 27 for the House of Representatives, not more than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) shall be expended for defraying the expenses 28 29 of and for the use of the members of the Mississippi Commission on Interstate Cooperation, as created under Section 5-5-1 et seq., 30 Mississippi Code of 1972. 31 \*HR05/A001\* 57 H. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 80 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 81 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying 82 the state's share of various assessments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 83 84 265,996.00. The Legislature shall have the authority to 93 94 escalate its budget and expend funds from the Legislative Extraordinary Session Expense Revolving Fund, as authorized in 95 96 Section 5-1-57, Mississippi Code of 1972, in accordance with rules 97 and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in \*HR05/A001\* H. 98 a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. The 99 authority granted in this section is provided for the purpose of 100 paying the expenses of the members of the Legislature incurred 101 during any Extraordinary Session of the Legislature occurring 102 during the period beginning July 1, 2005, and ending 103 June 30, 2006.

SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee as authorized in House Bill No. 1726, Regular Session of 2004, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006...... \$ 100,000.00.

SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying salaries, mileage, insurance, matching funds and the daily expense allowance of the members of the Legislature for the Second Extraordinary Session of 2005 and other expenses as follows:

126 **SECTION 8.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 127 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 128 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 129 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2005, with the exception of Section 7 which shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
