AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE OFFICE OF CAPITAL POST-CONVICTION COUNSEL OF 2 3 THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 7 8 defraying the expenses of the Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel of the State of Mississippi for the fiscal year beginning 9 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.....\$ 10 164,250.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel which is comprised of special source funds 14 15 collected by or otherwise available to the office for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 16\$ 17 870,773.00. 18 SECTION 3. 42 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 43 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 48 49 Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 50 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 51 52 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 53 54 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 55 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 56 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 57

58 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 59 Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel shall have the authority 60 to accept, budget and expend any source funds not to exceed Two H. B. No. 63 *HR05/A098*

052E/HR05/A098 PAGE 2 (RM\ST) Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00). Such funds are to be escalated in accordance with procedures for federal fund escalations as established in Section 27-104-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, and expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the State Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 67 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 68 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 69 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 70 71 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 72 73 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 74 and after July 1, 2005.
