HOUSE BILL NO. 66

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 1 MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI LIBRARY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL 2 3 YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and 7 8 maintenance of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying out the provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, 9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending 10 June 30, 2006..... \$ 10,842,010.00. 11 12 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 13 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi 14 15 Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the 16 purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal 17 18 year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 19\$ 2,896,315.00. 20 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below 21 22 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 23 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 24 Personal Services: 25 26 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 2,063,261.00 27 Travel and Subsistence..... 25,000.00 *HR05/A245*

44	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
45	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
46	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006
47	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
48	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the
49	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
50	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
51	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
52	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 54 55 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 56 57 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 58 59 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 60 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services"

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61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 63 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 67 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 68 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 69 The 70 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 72 73 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

78 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 79 80 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 81 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 82 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 83 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 84 85 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 86 87 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 88 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 89 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 90 91 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 92 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 93 authorized in this act.

H. B. No. 66 *HR05/A245* 052E/HR05/A245 PAGE 3 (RM\ST) 94 Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems 95 under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid 96 quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 97 31 and June 30.

98 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 99 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting 100 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 101 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 102 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 103 104 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 105 106 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 107 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee for Fiscal Year 2007.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated herein, not less than One Million Eighty-six Thousand Three Hundred Forty Dollars (\$1,086,340.00) shall be expended for the Magnolia Database.

147 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 148 Executive Director of the Mississippi Library Commission may increase major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to 149 exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of 150 151 each major object of expenditure, provided that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar 152 153 amount and provided the Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Finance and Administration also approves with 154 written authorization. However, no transfers shall be authorized 155 156 which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages 157 and Fringe Benefits."

158 **SECTION 10.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 159 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

This act shall take effect and be in force from 165 and after July 1, 2005.
