## HOUSE BILL NO. 72

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Soil and
8	Water Conservation Commission for the purpose of defraying the
9	administrative expenses of the commission and carrying out the
10	provisions of Section 69-27-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972,
11	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending
12	June 30, 2006\$ 685,101.00.
13	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
15	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Soil and
16	Water Conservation Commission which is comprised of special source
17	funds collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for
18	the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the
19	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
20	\$ 3,314,070.00.
21	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
22	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
23	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
24	expenditure:

45	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
46	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
47	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
48	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006
49	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
50	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the
51	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
52	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
53	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
54	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
55	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
56	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
57	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal
58	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
59	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
60	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
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    has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
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    projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services"
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    appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
    reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
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    requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
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    such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
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         Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
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    the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
    allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
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    Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
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    approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
    Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
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    approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
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    without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
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    appropriated level.
         No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
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    used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
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    being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
    act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
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         The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
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    award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
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    realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
    means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
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    specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of
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    teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
    next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
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    educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
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    Accountant License or higher level professional certification as
    determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
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    of a departing employee with an individual from within state
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    service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
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    departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
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pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be

- 96 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 97 State Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall maintain
- 98 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 99 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 100 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 101 maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of
- 102 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 103 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 104 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 105 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request
- 106 process.
- 107 **SECTION 5.** The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission
- 108 is hereby authorized to retain all funds generated from the sale
- 109 of equipment. Any funds made available from the sale of equipment
- 110 shall be deposited into the special fund in the State Treasury to
- 111 the credit of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and shall
- 112 be used solely for the purpose of purchasing equipment.
- 113 SECTION 6. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission
- 114 is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend any proceeds
- 115 derived from the sale of bonds authorized in Section 69-27-331 et
- 116 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. All expenditures shall be in
- 117 accordance with conditions provided in Section 69-27-331 et seq.,
- 118 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 119 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 120 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall have the authority to
- 121 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed
- 122 Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) in accordance
- 123 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- 124 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 125 federal funds.

126	SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the
127	intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed
128	Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) be used for the purpose
129	of funding a Beaver Control Cost Share program. The Mississippi
130	Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall promulgate rules and
131	regulations for the establishment and operation of the program on
132	a fund matching basis with the county unit of government. Funds
133	not expended or encumbered in a county may be transferred to
134	another county during the fiscal year. Only those funds
135	specifically appropriated for the Beaver Control Cost Share
136	program shall be used in any such program.
137	SECTION 9. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of
138	Seventy-seven Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-three Dollars
139	(\$77,763.00) is hereby assessed on any nonfederal special funds
140	and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in
141	Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October
142	1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi
143	for administrative costs.
144	SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
145	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
146	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
147	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
148	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
149	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
150	SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from
151	and after July 1, 2005.
