HOUSE BILL NO. 73

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY, FOR THE 2 3 FISCAL YEAR 2006; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 7 8 defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending 9 June 30, 2006..... \$ 7,970,606.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds 14 15 collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal 16 year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 17 3,367,434.00. 18 \$ 19 SECTION 3. 78 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 79 80 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 81 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 82 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 83 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 84 85 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 86 87 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 88 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 89 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 90 91 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 92 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 93 authorized in this act.

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SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 94 95 Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete 96 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 97 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 98 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 99 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 100 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 101 102 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 103

104 SECTION 5. The Mississippi Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, 105 106 donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 107 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or 108 109 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and 110 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 111 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History.

119 **SECTION 7.** It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 120 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 121 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 122 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

SECTION 9. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

205 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 206 Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept, 207 budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand 208 Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to 209 the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section 210 27-19-56.69(8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New Capitol, the 211 212 Old Capitol, the Governor's Mansion, and the War Memorial 213 Building, in accordance with rules and regulations of the 214 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 215

SECTION 11. Of the funds provided under the provisions of this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) is provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only President of the Confederate States of America.

SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the Department of Archives and History may authorize increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided H. H. B. No. 73 052E/HR05/A475 PAGE 7 (RM\ST) that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

SECTION 13. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of One Hundred Thirty-two Thousand One Hundred Thirty-four Dollars (\$132,134.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

237 SECTION 14. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 238 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 239 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 240 241 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 242 243 SECTION 15. This act shall take effect and be in force from 244 and after July 1, 2005.
