5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending
10	June 30, 2006\$ 7,970,606.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of
14	Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds
15	collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the
16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal
17	year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006

It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 100 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 101 102 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 103 104 SECTION 5. The Mississippi Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, 105 106 donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 107 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or 108 109 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and 110 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 111 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 112 113 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with 114 115 the cost of providing such services. - 208 Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to
- 209 the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section
- 210 27-19-56.69(8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of
- 211 paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New Capitol, the
- 212 Old Capitol, the Governor's Mansion, and the War Memorial
- 213 Building, in accordance with rules and regulations of the

- 216 **SECTION 11.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of

- 219 Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only
- 220 President of the Confederate States of America.
- 221 **SECTION 12.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 222 Executive Director of the Department of Archives and History may
- 223 authorize increases in any major objects of expenditures in total
- 224 amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the

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225 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided

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226	that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a
227	corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be
228	authorized which increase the major object of expenditure
229	"Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."
230	SECTION 13. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of One
231	Hundred Thirty-two Thousand One Hundred Thirty-four Dollars
232	(\$132,134.00) is hereby assessed on any nonfederal special funds
233	and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in
234	Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October
235	1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi
236	for administrative costs.
237	SECTION 14. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
238	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
239	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
240	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
241	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
242	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
243	SECTION 15. This act shall take effect and be in force from
244	and after July 1, 2005.
