5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Grand Gulf Military Monument
9	Commission in the operation and maintenance of the Grand Gulf
LO	Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and
L1	ending June 30, 2006\$ 212,636.00.
L2	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L3	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
L4	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Grand Gulf
L5	Military Monument Commission, for the purpose of defraying the
L6	expenses of the commission in the operation and maintenance of the
L7	Grand Gulf Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning
L8	July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006 \$ 166,895.00.

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         Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
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    the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or

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    Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
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    approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.

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    Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
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    approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
    without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
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    appropriated level.
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         No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
    used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
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    being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
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    act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
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         The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
    award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
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    realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
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    means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
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    specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of
    teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
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    next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
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    educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
    Accountant License or higher level professional certification as
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    determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
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    of a departing employee with an individual from within state
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    service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
    departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
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    pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
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    determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise

authorized in this act.

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94	<b>SECTION 4.</b> It is the intention of the Legislature that the
95	Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission shall maintain complete
96	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
97	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
98	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
99	Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
100	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be
101	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
102	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
103	provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.
104	SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or
105	other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of
106	any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of
107	Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for
108	any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of
109	Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.
110	It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles
111	authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply
112	with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.
113	SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
114	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
115	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
116	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
117	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
118	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
119	SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from
120	and after July 1, 2005.
