HOUSE BILL NO. 101

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE PORT AUTHORITY AT GULFPORT 2 3 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out 6 7 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available 8 to the Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the authority for the fiscal 9 year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 10 \$ 33,752,311.00. 11 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 12 13 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 14 15 expenditure: 16 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: Personal Services: 17 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 18 3,513,428.00 Travel and Subsistence..... 19 135,050.00 20 Contractual Services..... 6,156,475.00 21 Commodities..... 596,440.00 22 Capital Outlay: 19,520,000.00 23 Other Than Equipment..... 661,500.00 24 Equipment..... 32 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 33 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

38 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall maintain 39 40 complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 41 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 42 maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of 43 44 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 45 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 46 47 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request 48 process.

49 SECTION 4. In the event of a natural disaster or other major catastrophe whereby the expenditure of funds above the limits 50 51 contained herein are deemed necessary to rapidly repair or restore 52 port facilities, the Port Authority and the Mississippi Development Authority, with the approval of the Department of 53 54 Finance and Administration, may escalate expenditures under 55 Section 1 and the major objects contained in Section 2. However, no escalation shall be authorized until source and availability of 56 such funds is shown. 57

58 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 59 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport is hereby authorized 60 to escalate and expend funds from any source in accordance with H. B. No. 101 *HR05/R73* 052E/HR05/R73 PAGE 2 (\) applicable rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
federal funds.

64 **SECTION 6.** The money appropriated under the provisions of 65 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper 66 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

67 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 68 and after July 1, 2005.
