4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
7	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of
8	Optometry, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board
9	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending
LO	June 30, 2006\$ 83,473.00.
L1	SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
L2	State Board of Optometry shall maintain complete accounting and
L3	personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
L4	appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
L5	same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
L6	2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
L7	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to
L8	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
L9	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
20	during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.
21	SECTION 3. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Three
22	Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-three Dollars (\$3,653.00) is hereby
23	assessed on any nonfederal special funds and shall be deposited to
24	the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301,
25	Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the
26	purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative
27	costs.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 28 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 29 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 30 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 31 32 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 33 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after July 1, 2005. 35
