HOUSE BILL NO. 107

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 2 3 MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 Treasury to the credit of the Public Service Commission Regulation 8 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Public Service Commission for the fiscal year beginning 9 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 10 \$ 5,261,198.00. 11 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 12 13 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 14 15 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 16 Personal Services: 17 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 18 3,530,314.00 Travel and Subsistence..... 19 350,000.00 20 Contractual Services..... 1,035,564.00 21 Commodities..... 115,000.00 22 Capital Outlay: 0.00 23 Other Than Equipment..... 223,320.00 24 Equipment..... 32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 34 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 36 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 45 46 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 47 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 48 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 49 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 50 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 53

54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 56 57 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 58 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 59 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 60 *HR05/R79* 107 H. B. No. 052E/HR05/R79

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61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 62 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 68 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 69 70 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 71 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 72 73 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 74 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 75 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 76 77 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 78 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 79 80 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 81 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 82 authorized in this act.

83 SECTION 3. None of the funds herein appropriated by this act 84 to the Public Service Commission shall be expended for any purpose 85 that is not actually required or necessary for performing any of 86 the powers or duties of the Mississippi Public Service Commission 87 that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state 88 or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or 89 federal law.

90 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 91 Public Service Commission shall maintain complete accounting and 92 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 93 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the H. B. No. 107 *HRO5/R79* 052E/HR05/R79 PAGE 3 (\) 94 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 95 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 96 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to 97 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 98 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 99 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 5. Of the funds provided in Section 1, the sum of Two Hundred Forty-eight Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-eight Dollars (\$248,258.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

107 SECTION 6. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 108 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury 109 110 to the credit of the Public Service Commission, for the purpose of 111 defraying the expenses of the Public Service Commission to administer the Mississippi Telephone Solicitation Act, for the 112 113 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 114 168,000.00.\$

Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

121 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 122 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 123 124 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 125 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 126 *HR05/R79* 107 H. 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127 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 128 and after July 1, 2005.
