THIRTY-THREE-YEAR COACHING CAREER OF COACH REX BERRYMAN AND 2 3 RECOGNIZING HIS REMARKABLE RECORD AS ONE OF THE STATE'S MOST 4 OUTSTANDING COACHES. 5 WHEREAS, Coach Rex Berryman of Mooreville High School has 6 established himself among the greatest coaches to grace the presence of a baseball field in the State of Mississippi; and 7 8 WHEREAS, having graduated from New Site High School in 1968, 9 Coach Berryman commenced his coaching career at Mooreville High 10 School in 1972 after having received his associate's degree from Northeast Mississippi Junior College in 1970 and his bachelor's 11 degree from Delta State University in 1972; and 12 13 WHEREAS, later attaining his master's degree in education in 1976 from Mississippi State University, Coach Berryman has coached 14 three sports in the course of his athletic career, baseball, 15 basketball and softball, and has attained 12 state championships 16 between the three of them; and 17 WHEREAS, currently athletic director at Mooreville High 18 19 School, Coach Berryman in the 33 years of coaching baseball, has served 29 of those years as basketball coach and 11 years as 20 21 softball coach, compiling a state record in baseball championships

23 championship with a record of 638-314; and three softball state 24 championships with a 377-105 record; and

with eight state titles and a 937-314 record; one basketball state

25 WHEREAS, a legend in his own right, he was elected to the 26 Mississippi Association of Coaches Crossroads Diamond Club Hall of 27 Fame in 1985, the Mississippi Association of Coaches Hall of Fame 28 and the Delta State Hall of Fame in 2004; and
