AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 STATE TREASURY TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI MOTOR 2 3 VEHICLE COMMISSION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as 5 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 6 7 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Motor Vehicle 8 Commission, as provided by Section 63-17-51 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said 9 Commission, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending 10 June 30, 2006.....\$ 247,823.00. 11 SECTION 2. 32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 34 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 36 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 45 46 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 47 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 48 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 49 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 50 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 53

54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 56 57 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 58 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 62 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 68 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 69 70 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 71 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 72 73 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 74 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 75 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 76 77 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 78 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 79 80 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 81 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 82 authorized in this act.

83 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 84 of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act shall 85 be expended to defray any expenses of the Motor Vehicle Commission 86 if said commission takes any official actions during Fiscal Year 87 2006 that serve directly or indirectly to reduce the payment to 88 the State General Fund of any sales tax on motor vehicles sold 89 within the State of Mississippi.

90 It is further the intention of the Legislature that if such 91 actions are taken by the Motor Vehicle Commission during Fiscal 92 Year 2006, the executive director and commission members shall be 93 held personally liable for repayment of any funds expended under S. B. No. 2017 *SS05/A839* 052E/SS05/A839 PAGE 3 94 the provisions of this act with said repayment to be made to the 95 State General Fund. The Attorney General is hereby authorized and 96 directed to undertake appropriate legal action to enforce the 97 provisions of this act and to recover said funds.

98 SECTION 4. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Eleven 99 Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-three Dollars (\$11,693.00) is hereby 100 assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited 101 to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, 102 Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the 103 purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative 104 costs.

105 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 106 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 107 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 108 109 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 110 111 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2005. 112
