AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 1 MAINTENANCE OF THE OFFICE OF STATE AID ROAD CONSTRUCTION OF THE 2 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 Treasury to the credit of the Office of State Aid Road 8 Construction Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Office of State Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi 9 Department of Transportation for the fiscal year beginning 10 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... \$ 138,934,862.00. 11 SECTION 2. 36 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 37 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 39 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 41 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43 44 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 46 act. 47 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 48 49 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 50 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 51 52 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 53 54 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 56 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 57 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 58 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. S. B. No. 2022 052E/SS05/A947 PAGE 2 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

71 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 72 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 73 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 74 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 75 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 76 77 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 78 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 79 80 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 81 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 82 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 83 84 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 85 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise authorized in this act. 86

87 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete 88 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 89 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 90 91 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 92 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 93 *SS05/A947* S. B. No. 2022 052E/SS05/A947 PAGE 3

94 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 95 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 96 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

97 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 98 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall have the authority to 99 accept, budget and expend funds, comprised of special funds to the office, not to exceed Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00) 100 for the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges 101 102 on the state's county roads. Such funds are to be escalated in accordance with procedures for federal fund escalations as 103 104 established in Section 27-104-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, and expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth 105 106 by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the 107 State Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 108 act, the Office of State Aid Road Construction is authorized to 109 110 reimburse Adams County in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand 111 Dollars (\$500,000.00) from unobligated State Aid Road funds allocated to Adams County for the 2004 - 2007 term of office of 112 113 members of the board of supervisors to match federal aid funds of 114 the Surface Transportation Program administered by the Mississippi Department of Transportation for the project known as Government 115 Fleet Road Extension that is designated as the Intermodal 116 Connector Route 83, Adams County, Mississippi. 117

118 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 119 120 of the Mississippi Senate and House of Representatives are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 121 122 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 123 124 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 125 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 126 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following *SS05/A947* S. B. No. 2022 052E/SS05/A947 PAGE 4

127 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 128 Mississippi State Legislature."

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 129 130 Office of State Aid Road Construction may accept, budget and 131 expend funds not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars 132 (\$300,000.00) out of funds received from the Mississippi 133 Development Authority as reimbursement for actual expenses incurred by the Office of State Aid Road Construction for 134 administering and providing engineering services to political 135 subdivisions as authorized under Section 65-4-15, Mississippi Code 136 137 of 1972, subject to and in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner 138 139 consistent with the escalation of federal funds. Any escalated 140 funds shall be deposited into the Office of State Aid Roads Administrative Fund, a special fund hereby created in the State 141 Treasury, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending 142 June 30, 2006. 143

144 SECTION 8. The office of State Aid Road Construction of the 145 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall be exempt from any 146 transfer of special funds into the State General Fund or the 147 Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, that is 148 directed or authorized by the Department of Finance and 149 Administration or by the State Treasurer.

150 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 151 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 152 153 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 154 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 155 156 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from 157 and after July 1, 2005.
