SENATE BILL NO. 2023

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE 2 EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF VETERINARY EXAMINERS 3 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** That the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Veterinary Examiners for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred by said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006......\$ 118,475.00.

SECTION 2. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

14 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 15 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 16 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 17 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi State Board of Veterinary Examiners is hereby authorized to accept, budget, and expend funds, not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) from any source in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

25 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 26 Veterinary Examiners Board shall maintain complete accounting and 27 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds

appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 35 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 36 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 37 38 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 39 40 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41 and after July 1, 2005. 42
