It is the intention of the Legislature that the 226 227 State Treasurer's Office may authorize increases in major objects 228 of expenditure in total amounts not to exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the appropriated amount of each major object of 229 230 expenditure, provided that other major objects of expenditure are 231 decreased by a corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers 232 shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits." 233 234 SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 235 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 236 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 237 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 238 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 239 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from 240

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and after July 1, 2005.
