SENATE BILL NO. 2034

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION 2 3 TECHNOLOGY SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 6 7 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available 8 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services, for the fiscal year 9 beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 10\$ 35,275,401.00. 11 SECTION 2. 32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 34 Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 36 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 45 46 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 47 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 48 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 49 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 50 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 53

54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 56 57 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 58 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 59 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 60 *SS05/A600* S. B. No. 2034 052E/SS05/A600

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61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 62 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 68 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 69 70 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 71 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 72 73 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 74 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 75 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 76 77 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 78 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 79 80 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 81 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 82 authorized in this act.

SECTION 3. In order to offset the cost of publishing the 83 84 annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory, the Mississippi 85 Department of Information Technology Services is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in its discretion, to offer 86 87 for advertising purposes, pages to be included in said Directory, 88 to accept bids, and to let contracts for said pages. The 89 contracts for said advertising purposes shall be let for definite periods not to exceed two (2) years. 90

91 It shall be the duty of the Mississippi Department of 92 Information Technology Services, if it is desired that advertising 93 shall be used, to approve all proposed advertising submitted for S. B. No. 2034 *SS05/A600* 052E/SS05/A600 PAGE 3

use within such annual Mississippi Official Telephone Directory. 94 95 The department is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in 96 its discretion, to reject any and all bids submitted, and if all 97 bids are rejected, the authority may negotiate a contract within 98 the limitations of the specifications so long as the terms of any 99 such negotiated contract are equal to or better than the comparable terms submitted by the lowest and best bidder. 100 No sectarian, un-American, political, partisan or immoral 101 102 advertisement, as determined solely by the authority or its 103 successor, shall be accepted.

All monies derived from sale of such advertising shall be deposited in the appropriate special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services.

SECTION 4. The Mississippi Department of Information 108 Technology Services is hereby authorized to receive additional 109 110 funds from any state agency or other source, including one hundred 111 percent (100%) general-fund agencies, for the purpose of providing data processing or telecommunications services to any governmental 112 113 organization contracting with the Mississippi Department of 114 Information Technology Services for such services. The 115 Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services is further authorized to escalate an amount not to exceed One Million 116 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and to increase, up to a maximum of twenty 117 118 (20) additional positions, the number of authorized positions listed in this act in order to provide the required data 119 120 processing or telecommunications services for such governmental 121 organizations, under the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration. 122

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is authorized for expenditure and for the established purpose of E-Government Special Fund 3602.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be expended by Information Technology Services unless assessments, fees or rate levels charged to other state agencies for services are at or below the January 1, 2005, fee structure level, except for the establishment of rates for a new or expanded service, and required increases due to costs not within the control of this agency.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 134 Department of Information Technology Services shall maintain 135 136 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 137 expenditure of all funds appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of 138 139 details as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the 140 intention of the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget 141 Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format 142 143 and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. 144

SECTION 8. Of the funds provided herein, the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thirteen Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars (\$1,513,337.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 152 SECTION 9. 153 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 154 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 155 156 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 157 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 158 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from 159 and after July 1, 2005.

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
