## SENATE BILL NO. 2036

1 2	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEARS 2005 AND 2006.		
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:		
4	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as		
5	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the		
6	State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the		
7	expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority for the fiscal		
8	year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006		
9	\$ 17,511,951.00.		
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
12	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Development Authority or		
13	the appropriate special fund for the purpose of defraying the		
14	expenses incurred in the operation of the various divisions of the		
15	authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending		
16	June 30, 2006\$ 97,014,491.00.		
17	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions		
18	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:		
19	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:		
20	Permanent: Full Time 264		
21	Part Time 2		
22	Time-Limited: Full Time 22		
23	Part Time 1		
24	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of		
25	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to		
26	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal		
27	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006		
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28 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
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- 29 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the
- 30 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
- 31 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 32 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 34 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 35 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 36 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal
- 37 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 38 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 39 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 40 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 41 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services"
- 42 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 43 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 44 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 45 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 47 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 48 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 49 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 50 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 51 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 52 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 53 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 54 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 59 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
- 60 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,

61	realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other		
62	means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless		
63	specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of		
64	teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the		
65	next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an		
66	educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public		
67	Accountant License or higher level professional certification as		
68	determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement		
69	of a departing employee with an individual from within state		
70	service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the		
71	departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,		
72	pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be		
73	determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise		
74	authorized in this act.		
75	SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance		
76	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of		
77	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized		
78	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the		
79	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,		
80	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted		
81	performance measures provided below:

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127 Mississippi Development Authority or any programs sponsored under
128 the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby authorized not
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- 129 to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and approved,
- 130 provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise
- 131 accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq., and
- 132 Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 133 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 134 Mississippi Development Authority is hereby authorized to
- 135 escalate, budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed
- 136 Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and
- 137 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a
- 138 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 139 **SECTION 8.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 140 Mississippi Development Authority shall maintain complete
- 141 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 142 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 143 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 144 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 145 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be
- 146 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 147 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 148 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.
- 149 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2,
- 150 the amount of Six Million Four Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Dollars
- 151 (\$6,462,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
- 152 provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism
- 153 Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2006, and shall not be
- 154 expended for any type of cultural exchange program. The
- 155 expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt
- 156 from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 157 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2,
- 158 the amount of One Million Five Hundred Sixty-seven Thousand

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159 Dollars (\$1,567,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary,

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is provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and
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     facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2006.
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     The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be
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     exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.
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          SECTION 11.
                      In addition to all other sums herein
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     appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
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     necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
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     General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi
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     Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for
     Mississippi Technology Alliance, for the fiscal year beginning
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     July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006 ...... $1,150,612.00.
          The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section
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     are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for
     support of Mississippi Technology Alliance to strengthen the
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     business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and
     growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more
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     high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi
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               The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and
     apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi
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     Development Authority.
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          SECTION 12. In addition to all other sums herein

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          The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and
     apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi
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     Development Authority.
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          SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
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the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, not more than Twenty

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- 193 Thousand (\$20,000.00) may be expended for Mississippi Development
- 194 Authority employee travel associated with business recruitment
- 195 activities conducted at the Mississippi event located in New York
- 196 City's Central Park.
- 197 **SECTION 14.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- 198 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members
- 199 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate
- 200 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony
- 201 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public
- 202 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening
- 203 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has
- 204 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or
- 205 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following
- 206 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the
- 207 Mississippi State Legislature."
- 208 **SECTION 15.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 209 of Section 2, Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) shall be
- 210 derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-
- 211 103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 212 **SECTION 16.** In addition to all other sums heretofore
- 213 appropriated, the sum of Thirty-five Million Dollars
- 214 (\$35,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
- 215 appropriated from Mississippi Development Authority fund number
- 216 34CW in order to fulfill the state's obligation relating to the MS
- 217 Beef Processors, LLC, during FY 2005, with any remaining balance
- 218 lapsing to the State General Fund, as authorized in House Bill
- 219 No.1 of the 2005 Second Extraordinary Session.
- 220 **SECTION 17.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 221 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 222 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 223 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 224 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 225 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

226 **SECTION 18.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 227 and after July 1, 2005, except for Section 16 which shall take 228 effect and be in force from and after its passage.
