AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE 1 EXPENSES OF THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Personnel Board for the 6 support and maintenance of the State Personnel Board for the 7 8 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 9\$ 5,141,279.00. SECTION 2. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 30 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 31 32 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006 33 34 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the 35 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 36 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 37 38 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 39 40 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 41 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal 42 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 43 44 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 45 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 46 47 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 48 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 49 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 50 51 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 52 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 53 54 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 55 56 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 57 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 58 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 59 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 60 appropriated level. *SS05/A614* S. 65 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 66 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 67 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 68 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 69 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 70 71 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 72 73 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 74 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 75 of a departing employee with an individual from within state service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 76 77 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 78 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 79 80 authorized in this act.

81 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 82 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 83 Treasury to the credit of the State Personnel Board Training Fund 84 account, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State 85 Personnel Board Training Seminars for the fiscal year beginning 86 July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006......\$ 567,711.00.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Personnel Board Training Fund shall have the authority, should additional funds become available, to escalate and expend those funds in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration, in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

96 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 97 Section 3, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be 98 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 99 expenditure:

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 111 112 State Personnel Board shall have the authority to escalate and expend funds received from state agencies for reimbursement of 113 114 costs associated with the hiring of court reporters used in the Employee Appeals Process. Such funds shall be received and 115 expended under the rules and regulations of the Department of 116 117 Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the 118 escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 6. Of the funds provided in Section 1, the sum of Two Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-nine Dollars (\$235,849.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

Of the funds provided in Section 3, the sum of Twenty-four Thousand Eight Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$24,818.00) is hereby assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative costs.

133 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 134 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 135 136 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer, and the State Fiscal 137 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 138 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 139 and after July 1, 2005. 140
