5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the State Department of Agriculture and
9	Commerce, including the Divisions of Support, Plant Industry and
LO	Farmers Central Market, for the fiscal year beginning
L1	July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006 \$ 7,271,375.00.
L2	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L3	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
L4	source funds, which are collected by or otherwise become available
L5	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Department
L6	of Agriculture and Commerce, including the Divisions of Support
L7	and Plant Industry and Farmers Central Market, for the fiscal year
L8	beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
L9	\$ 5,614,530.00.
20	The funds authorized for expenditure under the provisions of
21	this section include subscription fees produced from the Market
22	Bulletin and admission fees produced from the Mississippi

31	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
32	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
33	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
34	Services" for Fiscal Year 2007 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2006
35	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
36	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2007 budget by the
37	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
38	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
39	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
40	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
41	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
42	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
43	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal

- 71 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
- 72 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
- 73 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
- 74 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as
- 75 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
- 76 of a departing employee with an individual from within state
- 77 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
- 78 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
- 79 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
- 80 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
- 81 authorized in this act.
- 82 **SECTION 4.** The funds appropriated and authorized to be
- 83 expended under the provisions of this act shall be expended for
- 84 the purpose of defraying all expenses incurred by the State
- 85 Department of Agriculture and Commerce in the operation of all
- 86 programs and activities (except operation of the State Lime
- 87 Plants, Veterinary Laboratory, Pink Bollworm-Plant Quarantine
- 88 Inspection Stations and Fire Ant Program) authorized to be
- 89 conducted and carried on by said department; including, but not
- 90 limited to: the administration of the Feed, Fertilizer and Dairy
- 91 Act; the Weights and Measure Act; the Meat Inspection Act of 1968;
