The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 7 8 defraying the general expenses of the operation of the Mississippi National Guard for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and 9 ending June 30, 2006.....\$ 3,838,610.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Mississippi National 13 Guard, out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Camp Shelby Timber Fund-No. 3700, as created by Chapter 187, Laws 14 15 of 1954, as amended; the Army National Guard Programs Fund-No. 16 3701; the Camp Shelby Base Operations Fund-No. 3705; and the Air National Guard Programs Fund-No. 3709, for the purpose of carrying 17 18 out the provisions of applicable statutes and federal/state agreements for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending 19 20 June 30, 2006.....\$ 53,987,229.00. 21 **SECTION 3.** With the funds appropriated under the provisions 22 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 23 Full Time..... 729 24 Permanent: Part Time..... 25 0 26 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 44 27 Part Time..... 0

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

34 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 35 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be submitted to 36 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 37 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 38 during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

SECTION 5. All funds authorized to be expended herein shall 39 40 be expended and otherwise accounted for in accordance with the provisions of Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. 41 If not needed for other purposes, the Adjutant General is hereby 42 expressly authorized to invest any part of or all monies herein 43 44 appropriated out of the Camp Shelby Timber Fund at the highest 45 rate of interest obtainable and credit interest accruing on such investments to the respective fund. Such monies may be invested 46 47 in any short-term bonds, notes or other direct obligations of the United States of America or the State of Mississippi or any county 48 49 or municipality of this state, which said county or municipal bonds have been approved by a reputable bonds attorney or have 50 been validated by a decree of the court, and in any event the said 51 52 bonds, notes or obligations in which such funds are invested shall mature or be redeemable prior to the time the funds so invested 53 54 will be needed for the refund or refunds herein provided for.

55 SECTION 6. The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds 56 which may become available for the purpose of defraying the 57 expenses of the Mississippi National Guard is hereby authorized 58 and approved, provided such expenditures are reported and 59 otherwise handled in accordance with the state budget law, same 60 being Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds 62 which may become available to the Mississippi National Guard for 63 construction purposes is hereby authorized and approved, provided 64 such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise handled 65 in accordance with the state budget law, same being Section 66 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

67 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Two
68 Million Sixty-four Thousand Five Hundred Sixteen Dollars
69 (\$2,064,516.00) shall be derived from funds transferred from the
70 State Department of Education to the Mississippi National Guard
71 for the support of the Youth Challenge Program at Camp Shelby.

SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, Six Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Nine Hundred Sixtysix Dollars (\$693,966.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the operation of the Mississippi National Guard.

78 SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 79 80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 81 82 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 83 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 85 and after July 1, 2005.
