1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE AID AND SUPPORT OF THE PUBLIC COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the aid and support
8	of the public community and junior colleges for the fiscal year
9	beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006
10	\$ 79,767,321.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
13	Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75
14	and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, not otherwise
15	appropriated, for the aid and support of public community and
16	junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and
17	ending June 30, 2006\$ 31,375,725.00.
18	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
19	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Budget
20	Contingency Fund, created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code
21	of 1972, for the aid and support of the public community and
22	junior colleges, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and
23	ending June 30, 2006\$ 13,279,586.00.
24	SECTION 4. The funds appropriated in this act for the aid
25	and support of the public and community junior colleges shall be
26	apportioned in accordance with the following assigned weights:

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    equivalent, counting only students who reside within the State of
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    Mississippi. However, associate degree nursing students who
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    reside outside the State of Mississippi may be counted for pay
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    purposes.
         Virtual Community College hosted and provided courses may
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Virtual Community College hosted and provided courses may qualify on the basis of the prior year full-time equivalency of Virtual Community College hours generated during the summer, fall and spring semesters. Those semester credit hours being hosted and provided by one institution shall receive funding at the weight of 1.0.

Of the funds appropriated in the act for the aid and support
of the public community and junior colleges, funds up to One
Million Seven Hundred Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$1,717,000.00)
are provided to be set aside as a mechanism to hold harmless those
colleges that lose funding in the third year of a five-year
phase-in implementation period to a full-time equivalency (FTE)
funding formula.

The Director of the State Board for Community and Junior
Colleges, or his designee, shall audit each public community and
junior college and shall determine who shall be counted in each
college and shall certify the number to the State Board for
Community and Junior Colleges.

If, pending determination of the enrollment of students at the public community and junior colleges entitled to participate in this appropriation, as provided for in this subsection, the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges shall find and determine that any such public or community junior college does not have sufficient funds on hand for payment of the necessary expenses of its operation for the period commencing July 1, 2005,

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- 95 expressly authorized to make an advance to any such public

- 115 **SECTION 7.** The following public community and junior
- 116 colleges which qualify shall participate in the funds provided by
- 117 Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act:

161	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006.

164	participate in the State and School Employees' Life and Health
165	Insurance Plan. Any funds appropriated in this section which are
166	not expended during the fiscal year shall be carried forward for
167	the same purposes during the next succeeding fiscal year.
168	SECTION 11. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
169	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
170	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
171	establishing and operating One-Stop Career Centers at each of the
172	public community and junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning
173	July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006 \$ 4,500,000.00.
174	SECTION 12. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
175	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
176	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board for
177	Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose of defraying the
178	cost of Sign Language Interpreter Training at the public community
179	and junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005,
180	and ending June 30, 2006\$ 179,050.00.
181	SECTION 13. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
182	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
183	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board for
184	Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose of defraying the
185	cost of the Education Technology Program at the public community
186	and junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005,
187	and ending June 30, 2006\$ 3,599,160.00.
188	SECTION 14. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
189	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
190	Education Enhancement Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the
191	State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose of
192	defraying the cost of servicing the debt on bonds issued for the

196	The funds appropriated in this section shall be derived from
197	Education Enhancement Funds deposited pursuant to Sections
198	27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
199	SECTION 15. A Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition
200	(MPACT) program beneficiary shall be considered a Mississippi
201	resident for the purposes of participating in this appropriation
202	regardless of the beneficiary's residence on the date of
203	enrollment, as set out in Mississippi Code Annotated, Section
204	37-155-5(d)(iii).
205	SECTION 16. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
206	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
207	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
208	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
209	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
210	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
211	performance measures provided below:

251	cost of Advanced Training Centers at each of the Public Community
252	and Junior Colleges, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005,
253	and ending June 30, 2006\$ 2,250,000.00.
254	SECTION 18. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
255	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
256	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
257	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

- 258 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 259
- SECTION 19. This act shall take effect and be in force from 260
- 261 and after July 1, 2005.
