1 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER CERTAIN
2 SPECIAL FUNDS INTO THE BUDGET CONTINGENCY FUND DURING FISCAL YEAR
3 2006; TO DIRECT THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER A CERTAIN SUM
4 FROM FUND NO. 4201 TO FUND NO. 4230; TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE
5 TREASURER TO MAKE TRANSFERS TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST ON
6 BONDS AS THEY COME DUE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** The State Fiscal Officer shall transfer to the
9 Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, out of the
10 following enumerated special funds, the amount listed below for
11 each fund during the period beginning July 1, 2005, and ending
12 June 30, 2006:

63 **SECTION 2.** The State Fiscal Officer shall transfer Sixteen
64 Million Four Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-three
65 Dollars (\$16,421,923.00) from Fund No. 4201 to Fund No. 4230.

66 **SECTION 3.** Through June 30, 2006, the State Treasurer may
67 transfer from any funds in the State Treasury an amount to pay the
68 principal of and the interest on state general obligation bonds as
69 they become due.

70 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
71 and after July 1, 2005.
