1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE NESHOPA CENTRAL HIGH
2 SCHOOL "LADY ROCKETS" AND COACH TOMMY HOLLAND ON WINNING THE CLASS
3 4A GIRLS STATE FAST-PITCH SOFTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP.

5 Softball Team won the 2005 Class 4A Girls State Fast-Pitch
6 Softball Championship; and

7 WHEREAS, the Lady Rockets completed the 2005 season with an
8 overall record of 24 wins and only 5 losses; and

9 WHEREAS, the Neshoba Central Lady Rockets swept Petal in the
10 state championship series; and

11 WHEREAS, the hallmark of this championship team is its
12 stellar defense, which was instrumental in the Lady Rockets'
13 championship clinching 2-0 win over Petal; and

14 WHEREAS, in their march to the state championship, the Lady
15 Rockets rolled over Terry, New Hope, and Hernando in the
16 play-offs; and

17 WHEREAS, "I think we only had one error all day," said a
18 proud Neshoba Central Coach Tommy Holland. "We are a sound
19 defensive team, and that makes our pitching stronger. We know we
20 can give up a hit and the defense will make the difference"; and

21 WHEREAS, Senior Pitcher Kady Chandler, one of three senior
22 starters on the team, posted a 21-4 pitching record in 2005.
23 Other senior starters are shortstop Jessi Nowell and first baseman
24 Samantha Giambrone; and

26 accomplishments of this group of student athletes who have brought

27 honor to their school, their community and to the State of
28 Mississippi:
