## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 512

1            A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE OLE  
2 MISS "REBELS" BASEBALL TEAM AND COACH MIKE BIANCO FOR WINNING THE  
3 2005 SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE (SEC) WESTERN DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIP  
4 AND FOR ATTAINING THE BEST OVERALL RECORD IN THE SEC.

5            WHEREAS, Freshman Shortstop Zack Cozart hit two home runs and  
6 had four RBIs as No. 17. Ole Miss defeated No. 18 Arkansas 9-1 to  
7 complete a three-game sweep of the Southeastern Conference series  
8 on Sunday, May 22, 2005, in front of 7,270 fans at Baum Stadium in  
9 Fayetteville, Arkansas; and

10           WHEREAS, the victory secured Ole Miss a piece of its first  
11 SEC Western Division title since 1982, as the Rebels finished the  
12 2005 season tied with LSU for first place in the SEC Western  
13 Division with 18-12 conference marks; and

14           WHEREAS, Ole Miss also improved to 40-16 overall, best in the  
15 SEC and tying the school record for wins in a season set by the  
16 1995 team that finished 40-22. The Rebels' 18 SEC wins also tied  
17 the school record set last year; and

18           WHEREAS, the 2005 Southeastern Conference regular season  
19 ended full of tightly packed standings and weekends capable of  
20 swinging teams from first to last. The SEC tournament seeds hung  
21 in the balance and were only solidified when Ole Miss recorded the  
22 final out in its sweep of Arkansas; and

23           WHEREAS, Ole Miss entered the 2005 SEC Tournament as the No.  
24 4 seed and played No. 5 seed Alabama at Hoover Metropolitan  
25 Stadium in Hoover, Alabama; and

26           WHEREAS, Ole Miss Junior first baseman/left-handed pitcher  
27 Stephen Head and Junior outfielder Brian Pettway were two of four  
28 finalists for the 2005 Cellular South Ferriss Trophy, which is

29 awarded annually to Mississippi's top college baseball player, and  
30 the voters picked Brian Pettway on May 23, 2005; and

31 WHEREAS, the 2005 roster is as follows: Zack Cozart, Ryne
