1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE GREENVILLE ST.

3 ANGELA HENDRIX FOR WINNING THEIR 13TH TEAM STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

4 WHEREAS, the Greenville St. Joseph Catholic School "Fighting
5 Irish" Tennis Team is proud to boast its 13th team state
6 championship, and its 3rd straight state championship; and

7 WHEREAS, St. Joseph holds a MHSAA record for having the most
8 team championships of any school classification 1-5; and

9 WHEREAS, St. Joseph invites strong competition. They have
10 played teams consistently in the 2A-5A classifications during the
11 regular season. This year their regular season record was 11-1,
12 losing only to Oxford High School; and

13 WHEREAS, the district tournament was easily won by the
14 Fighting Irish making it their sixth straight division crown.
15 With seven teams participating, St. Joseph accrued 14 points,
16 which was twice the points of any other team; and

17 WHEREAS, individual wins for the gold include boys double
18 players, Cheston Cascio and Joseph Paul DeAngelo; girls doubles
19 players, Lauren Zepponi and Caroline Oakes; and

20 WHEREAS, Coach Angela Hendrix was chosen Mississippi
21 Association of Coaches "Tennis Coach of the Year" for 2005. She
22 previously won this honor in 2002; and
