PARKERSON AND COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING 2 3 HIM UPON HIS RETIREMENT AS COMMANDER OF THE 1108TH AVCRAD. 4 WHEREAS, after commencing his military career with the United States Marine Corps in 1971, Colonel Gervis A. Parkerson will 5 retire from duty after more than 34 years of dedicated, diligent 6 and commendable service to the United States Military and the 7 8 Mississippi Army National Guard; and WHEREAS, a lifelong resident of Mississippi, Colonel 9 Parkerson graduated from Gulfport High School in 1967, received 10 his bachelor of science degree from Mississippi State in 1971 and 11 joined the United States Marine Corps, completing OCS in Quantico, 12 13 Virginia; and WHEREAS, after graduating from Naval Flight School in 1972 14 15 and serving as base pilot in the Marine Corps through 1976, 16 Colonel Parkerson left active duty to return to his native Mississippi, where he commenced employment with Baxter Travenol 17 18 Labs through 1978; and WHEREAS, in 1979 he obtained employment with Beech Aerospace 19 20 (now Raytheon) and joined the Mississippi Army National Guard with 21 the 114th Support Group in 1980, beginning his full-time career at the 1108th AVCRAD in 1981 and becoming its commander in 1994; and 22 WHEREAS, leading the 1108th AVCRAD to fulfill its mission of 23 providing unit, intermediate, and limited depot level aviation 24 support maintenance to the nine southeastern states, the Virgin 25 26 Islands and Puerto Rico, Colonel Parkerson's ability to lead
