- AMEND by striking SECTION 38 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 3 **SECTION 38.** (1) There is created the Mississippi
- 4 Development Authority Legislative Oversight Committee to serve in
- 5 an advisory capacity to the Mississippi Development Authority
- 6 ("MDA") regarding matters under the jurisdiction of the MDA. The
- 7 committee shall consist of six (6) members, two (2) members to be
- 8 appointed by the Governor, two (2) Senators to be appointed by the
- 9 Lieutenant Governor and two (2) Representatives to be appointed by
- 10 the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The committee shall
- 11 have no jurisdiction or vote on any matter within the jurisdiction
- 12 of the MDA.
- 13 (2) The committee shall meet quarterly and may meet at other
- 14 times specified by the chairman of the committee.
- 15 (3) A quorum of the committee shall consist of four (4)
- 16 members. The committee shall elect from among its membership a
- 17 chairman and vice chairman.
- 18 (4) The MDA shall not be required to submit to the committee
- 19 any information that it considers confidential or proprietary, or
- 20 anything the disclosure of which may negatively affect a project
- 21 it has under consideration.
- 22 (5) Members of the committee who are not legislators, state
- 23 officials or state employees shall be compensated at the per diem

- 24 rate authorized by Section 25-3-69 and shall be reimbursed in
- 25 accordance with Section 25-3-41 for mileage and actual expenses
- 26 incurred in the performance of their duties. Legislative members
- 27 of the committee shall be paid from the contingent expense funds
- 28 of their respective houses in the same manner as provided for
- 29 committee meetings when the Legislature is not in session.
- 30 However, no per diem or expense for attending meetings of the
- 31 committee may be paid to legislative members of the committee
- 32 while the Legislature is in session. No committee member may
- 33 incur per diem, travel or other expenses unless previously
- 34 authorized by vote, at a meeting of the committee, which action
- 35 shall be recorded in the official minutes of the meeting.
- 36 Nonlegislative members shall be paid from any funds made available
- 37 to the committee for that purpose.
- 38 (6) The terms of the legislative members of the committee
- 39 shall expire at the end of their terms of office, and the
- 40 Governor's appointees shall serve for a term concurrent with the
- 41 term of office of the appointing Governor. Any vacancy on the
- 42 advisory committee shall be filled by appointment by the original
- 43 appointing authority for the remainder of the members' unexpired
- 44 term.
