HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY URGING THE MISSISSIPPI 1 2 CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO VIGOROUSLY SUPPORT THE FULL APPROPRIATION OF PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED THIRD-YEAR HAVA FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF APPROXIMATELY \$6 MILLION AND FOR ADDITIONAL MONIES FOR DISASTER RELIEF FOR THE ELECTIONS INFRASTRUCTURE OF THE STATE 3 4 5 6 OF MISSISSIPPI THAT HAS BEEN DAMAGED BY HURRICANE KATRINA. 7 Whereas, the United States Congress has authorized the 8 distribution of approximately \$34 million to the State of Mississippi over a three-year period to defray the costs 9 10 associated with implementation of the Help America Vote Act of 11 2002; and Whereas, third-year funding for these authorized 12 distributions amounting to approximately \$6 million has not yet 13 been appropriated and has, therefore, not been received by the 14 State of Mississippi; and 15 Whereas, Hurricane Katrina destroyed much of the elections 16 17 infrastructure in many counties in the State of Mississippi struck by this storm, including the destruction of polling places and 18 damage to courthouses and to election equipment and records, and 19 20 the extent of said damage is not yet known; and 21 Whereas, Hurricane Katrina has severely curtailed revenue to 22 the State of Mississippi making the need for third-year HAVA 23 funding even more acute; and 24 Whereas, even had the hurricane not struck Mississippi, there was already a pressing need for funds to purchase additional 25 voting machines for the counties of the state in order for them to 26 27 fully comply with the federally mandated requirements of HAVA; and Whereas, without third-year federal funding in the authorized 28 29 amount of approximately \$6 million, those counties struck by *HR07/R132* 1 H. R. No. N1/2055E/HR07/R132 PAGE 1 ($GT \setminus HS$)

30 Hurricane Katrina can not possibly comply with HAVA by the January 31 1, 2006, deadline:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 32 33 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby 34 respectfully urge the Mississippi Congressional Delegation to 35 vigorously support the full appropriation of previously authorized third-year HAVA funding in the State of Mississippi in the amount 36 37 of approximately \$6 million and for additional monies for disaster relief for the elections infrastructure of the State of 38 Mississippi that has been damaged or destroyed. 39
