HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 11

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE DILIGENCE AND TACTICAL PLANNING 1 OF SERGEANT MIKE STEPHENS OF THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE RESERVE 2 3 FOR ASSISTING IN THE EVACUATION OF HOUSTON'S FLEEING EVACUEES FROM 4 THE IMPENDING DANGERS OF HURRICANE RITA.

5 WHEREAS, as Hurricane Rita raged on a path of destruction, destination the southern shores of Texas, Sgt. Mike Stephens of 6 7 the United States Air Force Reserve, who makes his home in Katy, Texas, had a plan to assist as many people as possible to escape 8 9 the impending devastation; and

10 WHEREAS, this evacuation plan consisted of having previously mapped out an escape route that would not incur the inconvenience 11 and madness of total gridlock on the state's major interstate and 12 13 freeway system; and

WHEREAS, a full-time employee of United Parcel Service (UPS), 14 Sqt. Stephens had tactically planned and prepared for the worst, 15 16 mapping out the evacuation, prepared lodging for ten persons with a military tent, sleeping bags, battery powered radios, flash 17 lights, meal and food rations to last approximately two weeks and 18 19 a propane grill for the preparing of the meals; and

WHEREAS, leading a caravan of four vehicles and ten 20 21 individuals, infants and seniors included, Sgt. Stephens' group was able to drive an estimated 65 miles per hour on the rural and 22 23 less traveled roads of Texas to get his followers out of harms way; and 24

WHEREAS, the course of action taken by Sgt. Stephens allowed 25 26 those in his care to make a safe and timely exit as opposed to others who were overcome by the congested thoroughfares within the 27 state's borders in excess of twelve hours; and 28
