1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF
2 OFFICER JAMES C. "JAMIE" WALKER AND EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO
3 HIS FAMILY AND FRIENDS UPON HIS PASSING.

4 WHEREAS, Officer James C. "Jamie" Walker, born May 11, 1973,
5 to Sonny and Linda Walker in Waynesboro, Mississippi, departed
6 this earthly life on Wednesday, September 28, 2005, in furtherance
7 of serving and protecting the citizens of Waynesboro, causing
8 great sorrow and loss to his family and friends; and

9 WHEREAS, a two-year veteran officer with the Waynesboro
10 Police Department, Officer Walker was known for his valued work
11 ethic and went above and beyond the call of duty; and

22 Walker, whose gift to the City of Waynesboro and the State of
