SENATE BILL NO. 2020

1 AN ACT TO EXTEND STATUTES OF LIMITATIONS FOR CERTAIN CAUSES 2 OF ACTION IN THE SECOND SUPREME COURT DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED 3 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. As a result of the catastrophic impact of Hurricane Katrina, the statute of limitations applicable to any 6 action not filed in any state or federal court or administrative 7 8 forum as of August 29, 2005, for which venue was proper in a county located in the Second (Southern) Supreme Court District as 9 defined by Section 9-3-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is extended as 10 follows: If the statute of limitations expires on or after the 11 effective date of this act, through and including Monday, November 12 13 28, 2005, then the time for filing a claim shall be extended to Friday, December 30, 2005. 14

15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 16 and after its passage.
