- 4 WHEREAS, the public school districts located on the
- 5 Mississippi Gulf Coast and in the other geographical areas of the
- 6 State of Mississippi declared a federal disaster area due to the
- 7 unprecedented damage of Hurricane Katrina are facing an
- 8 unprecedented loss of local revenue; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the enormity of the loss in local revenue due to the
- 10 decrease in assessed property, ad valorem tax valuation and
- 11 decreased tax receipts will affect these public school districts
- 12 and negatively impact the quality of education provided to
- 13 Mississippi children for several years; and
- 14 WHEREAS, it will be difficult for the state to make up this
- 15 loss to the local school districts, particularly in light of
- 16 continued requests to increase and maintain its contributions to
- 17 public school districts through 100% funding of the adequate
- 18 education program; and
- 19 WHEREAS, bankers, investors and insurance executives continue
- 20 to be concerned about the ability of local governments and school
- 21 districts affected by this hurricane to pay their outstanding
- 22 long-term debt; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Department of Education has
- 24 submitted a plan of assistance to the United States Secretary of
- 25 Education and members of Congress, and the Mississippi Legislature

- 26 requests that federal financial assistance be provided for a
- 27 four-year period:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 29 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
- 30 we respectfully request that the leadership and members of the
- 31 United States Congress take whatever actions necessary to adopt
- 32 measures that will provide much needed federal financial
- 33 assistance to public school districts in Mississippi to offset the
- 34 loss of local revenue needed to provide quality education to
- 35 Mississippi children impacted by Hurricane Katrina.
- 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be forwarded to
- 37 the President of the United States, the Secretary of the United
- 38 States Office of Education, members of the Mississippi
- 39 congressional delegation and the State Board of Education, and be
- 40 make available to the Capitol Press Corps.
