- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It is unlawful for any person to use a
- 6 cellular telephone while operating a motor vehicle without using
- 7 hands-free accessories. The term "hands-free accessories," as
- 8 used in this section, means a device or devices that allow a motor
- 9 vehicle operator to speak on a cellular telephone without holding
- 10 such telephone or some part of such telephone with his hands.
- 11 (2) Any person who violates the provisions of this section
- 12 shall be subject to the following penalties:
- 13 (a) Upon conviction of a first offense, the person
- 14 shall be fined One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00).
- 15 (b) Upon conviction of a second offense, the offenses
- 16 being committed within a three-year period, the person shall be
- 17 fined Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00).
- 18 (c) Upon conviction of a third or subsequent offense,
- 19 the offenses being committed within a three-year period, the
- 20 person shall be fined Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), shall be
- 21 imprisoned for six (6) months in the county jail and shall be
- 22 sentenced to community service work for not less than ten (10)
- 23 days.
- 24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after July 1, 2006.
