- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** No employer doing business in the State of
- 7 Mississippi may ask on an employment application whether or not
- 8 the applicant has been convicted of a felony. However, nothing in
- 9 this act shall be construed as prohibiting an employer from
- 10 conducting a criminal background check on such applicant, and
- 11 nothing in this act shall be construed as forcing an employer to
- 12 hire a convicted felon.
- 13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 14 and after July 1, 2006.
