- SECTION 1. Section 19-31-51, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9
- 10 amended as follows:
- 19-31-51. (1) No public improvement district established 11
- under this chapter shall provide any utility service described in 12
- Section 77-3-3(d) to or for the public for compensation without 13
- 14 first obtaining a certificate of public convenience and necessity
- 15 from the Public Service Commission.
- (2) Nothing contained in this section shall prohibit the 16
- 17 Public Service Commission from issuing a certificate of public
- convenience and necessity to any person for service in 18
- 19 uncertificated areas within public improvement district
- 20 boundaries.
- Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, water and/or 21
- sewer districts that petition the Public Service Commission for a 22
- 23 certificate of public convenience and necessity for any
- uncertificated area shall give written notice. Such notice may be 24
- 25 given by publication of a display advertisement that is two (2)
- columns wide by five (5) inches deep one (1) time in a newspaper 26
- of general circulation within the county or counties wherein the 27
- 28 described district is located or by regular mail to all property
- owners located in such area, as reflected on the tax rolls of the 29
