6	SECTION 1. Section 19-5-307, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

8	19-5-307. (1) When any district is created, the board of
9	supervisors of the county creating $\underline{\text{the}}$ district may appoint a
LO	board of commissioners composed of <u>at least</u> seven (7) members to
L1	govern its affairs, and shall fix the domicile of the board at any
L2	point within the district. The members of the board shall be
L3	qualified electors of the district, two (2) of whom shall be
L4	appointed for terms of two (2) years, three (3) for terms of three
L5	(3) years, and two (2) for terms of four (4) years, dating from
L6	the date of the adoption of the ordinance creating the district.
L7	Thereafter, all appointments of the members shall be for terms of
L8	four (4) years.
L9	Any county that intersects Interstate Highway 20 and
20	Interstate Highway 55 shall have one (1) appointment to the 911

- 29 (5) appointments to the 911 Emergency Commission. All
- 30 appointments for any county that intersects Interstate Highway 20
- 31 and Interstate Highway 55 shall be residents of the municipality
- 32 and must be appointed by the mayor of that municipality within

- 34 (2) The board of commissioners shall have complete and sole
