30 authorized to be expended by the Legislature, and the presidents 31 and trustees of all state-supported colleges, universities and 32 junior colleges;

33 (e) Members of any state board, commission or agency, 34 including the Mississippi Ethics Commission, charged with the administration or expenditure of public funds, with the exception 35 of advisory boards or commissions; provided, however, in order to 36 37 fulfill the legislative purposes of this chapter, the commission may require, upon a majority vote, the filing of a statement of 38 economic interest by members of an advisory board or commission. 39 40 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006. 41
