6	SECTION 1. Section 49-1-14, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	49-1-14. (1) Each person employed by the Commission on
9	Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks as (a) a conservation officer; or
10	(b) a state park ranger who meets the requirements of subsection
11	(2) of this section, who retires for superannuation or for reason
12	of disability under the Public Employees' Retirement System * * *,
13	upon his request, $\underline{\text{may}}$ be allowed $\underline{\text{by the commission}}$ to retain, as
14	his personal property, one (1) side arm which was issued to him,
15	during his service, provided funds are available for such purpose.
16	(2) In order to be eligible to retain a side arm issued to
17	him under subsection (1) of this section, a retiring conservation
18	officer or state park ranger must have attended and successfully
19	completed the law enforcement curriculum at the Mississippi Law
20	Enforcement Officers' Training Academy, and must be certified as a
21	qualified law enforcement officer by the Board on Law Enforcement
22	Officer Standards and Training.
