## HOUSE BILL NO. 331

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21-3-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT ADVANCE NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE MAYOR AND 2. BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF A MUNICIPALITY SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED FOR 3 4 SPECIAL MEETINGS CALLED DURING CONDITIONS OF EMERGENCY; AND FOR 5 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 21-3-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8
- 9 (1) The mayor or any two (2) aldermen may, by
- written notice, call a special meeting of the mayor and board of 10
- aldermen for the transaction of important business. The notice 11
- must state the time of meeting and distinctly specify the subject 12
- matters of business to be acted upon and be signed by the officer 13
- 14 or officers calling the meeting. Notice of the meeting shall be
- given to the members of the board, including the mayor, who have 15
- 16 not signed it and who can be found, at least three (3) hours
- before the time fixed for the meeting. The method of notice shall 17
- be entered on the minutes of the special meeting, and business not 18
- 19 specified therein shall not be transacted at the meeting.
- member of the board shall not receive pay for attending a special 20

- 22 (2) Prior notice of a special meeting of the mayor and board
- of aldermen as required under subsection (1) of this section shall 23
- not be applicable to special meetings called during conditions of 24
- emergency as defined under Section 33-15-5(h); however, notice of 25
- any such meeting shall be posted within one (1) hour after such 26
- 27 meeting is called in a prominent place available to examination
- and inspection by the general public and a copy of the notice, 28

- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 32
