HOUSE BILL NO. 392

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER 4, LAWS OF 2005, SECOND 1 EXTRAORDINARY SESSION, AND SECTION 5 OF CHAPTER 101, LAWS OF 2005, 2 SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION, TO CLARIFY THAT FUNDS RECEIVED AS A SETTLEMENT PAYMENT FROM MCI, INC., MAY BE USED BY THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AS A CREDIT AGAINST THE INCREASE IN 3 4 5 б THE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION FOR UNIVERSITIES, COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR 7 COLLEGES AND PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 4, Laws of 2005, Second 9 10 Extraordinary Session, is amended as follows: Section 1. (1) The State Fiscal Officer shall transfer 11 general funds in the amounts listed below to the specified 12 agencies and accounts held in the State Treasury during the period 13 14 beginning upon the passage of this act: 15 AGENCY/FUND FUND NO. AMOUNT Public Employees' Retirement System \$ 50,000,000.00 16 3531 17 Mississippi Development Authority 34CW \$ 35,000,000.00 Mississippi Department of Public Safety 3711 \$ 5,000,000.00 18 UMC - Cancer Institute \$ 10,000,000.00 19 3283 20 TOTAL \$100,000,000.00 It is the intent of the Legislature to transfer certain 21 (2) 22 funds paid into the State General Fund upon receipt thereof by 23 MCI, Inc., on behalf of itself and reorganized debtors as the 24 settlement payment and release under Chapter 11 Case No. 02-13533: (a) to the Mississippi Public Employees' Retirement System 25 administration fund to be utilized by the system as a credit for 26 agencies or entities receiving general funds as follows: (i) for 27 28 state agencies, the credit will be against the one percent (1%) increase attributable to general fund employer contributions only; 29 *HR03/R155.1* H. 30 and (ii) for universities, community and junior colleges and 31 public school districts, the credit will be against the one 32 percent (1%) increase attributable to funds from all sources 33 except federal funds; (b) to the Mississippi Development Authority 34 during fiscal year 2005 in order to fulfill the state's 35 obligations relating to the Mississippi Beef Processors, LLC, up to Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00), as necessary, 36 with any remaining balance to lapse into the State General Fund; 37 (c) to the Mississippi Department of Public Safety, Three Million 38 Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) of which shall be used to fund a Highway 39 40 Patrol Cadet Class, and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) shall be used to purchase equipment; and (d) to the University of 41 42 Mississippi Medical Center Cancer Institute in order to fund the operation of the Institute during fiscal years 2006 and 2007. 43 SECTION 2. Section 5 of Chapter 101, Laws of 2005, Second 44 Extraordinary Session, is amended as follows: 45 46 Section 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, as 47 authorized in House Bill No. 1 of the 2005 Second Extraordinary Session, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 48 49 necessary, is hereby appropriated from Fund 3531 to be utilized by the system as a credit for agencies or entities receiving general 50 51 funds as follows: (a) for state agencies, the credit will be against the one percent (1%) increase attributable to general fund 52 employer contributions only; and (b) for universities, community 53 54 and junior colleges and public school districts, the credit will be against the one percent (1%) increase attributable to funds 55 56 from all sources except federal funds for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 57 50,000,000.00. 58 \$ SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 59 60 and after its passage.

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
