## HOUSE BILL NO. 399

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REMOVE THE ADDITIONAL FEE REQUIRED TO BE PAID BY VOLUNTEER FIRE 3 FIGHTERS IN ORDER TO BE ISSUED A DISTINCTIVE FIRE FIGHTER LICENSE 4 TAG; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 27-19-56.1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a fire 9 fighter, including a career fire fighter, a volunteer fire fighter 10 or an industrial fire fighter, employed by or in the service of any municipality, county, fire district, state agency or industry 11 in the state who is a resident of this state, or who is a retired 12 fire fighter who is a resident of this state, upon payment of the 13 road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration 14 fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, 15 16 pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of any additional fee required under subsection (3) of 17 this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each 18 19 motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a fire fighter or retired fire fighter. The distinctive license 20 21 tags so issued shall be of such color and design as may be agreed upon by the Executive Committee of the Mississippi Fire Fighters 22 23 Association and the State Tax Commission, shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish 24 each license tag and may, in the discretion of the State Tax 25 26 Commission, display the county name.

27 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 28 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms H. B. No. 399 \*HRO3/R574\* G3/5 06/HR03/R574 PAGE 1 (JWB\LH) 29 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such 30 distinctive license tags (a) shall present to the issuing official 31 proof of their employment or service as a fire fighter by 32 presentation of the applicant's official fire fighter 33 identification card or a signed and notarized affidavit from the 34 governing authority or chief executive officer of the 35 municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry by or for 36 whom the applicant is employed or serves as a fire fighter; or (b) shall present proof that they are a retired fire fighter by 37 38 presentation of a signed and notarized affidavit from the 39 governing authority or chief executive officer of the municipality, county, fire district, agency or industry from whom 40 41 the fire fighter retired. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less three percent 42 (3%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be 43 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as 44 45 prescribed by the commission. The portion of any additional fee required to be imposed under subsection (3) of this section that 46 is retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 47 48 county general fund.

(3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 49 50 after July 1, 2006, any person, except a volunteer fire fighter, who applies for a distinctive license tag under this section shall 51 pay an additional fee in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for 52 53 each distinctive license tag applied for under this section which shall be in addition to all other taxes and fees. The additional 54 55 fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag year. The additional fee is due 56 57 and payable at the time the original application is made for a distinctive license tag under this section and thereafter annually 58 59 at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains 60 the distinctive license tag. 62 not wish to retain the distinctive license tag, or if the owner 63 resigns from or otherwise vacates his employment or service as a 64 fire fighter, he must surrender it to the local county tax 65 collector.

66 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 67 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the 68 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of 69 70 distinctive license tags. The State Treasurer shall distribute an amount equal to Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the additional fees 71 72 collected from the issuance of such distinctive license tags issued under this section to the State General Fund, and the 73 74 remainder of such additional fees collected shall be distributed by the State Treasurer to the credit of the special fund created 75 76 in Section 7-9-70.

77 A regular license tag must be properly displayed as (5) 78 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 79 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 80 81 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 82 83 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 84 tag.

(6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 85 86 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 87 88 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 89 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 90 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 91 92 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 93 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 94 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

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In lieu of the distinctive license tag authorized under 95 (7) subsections (1) through (6) of this section, any person who 96 presents proof of his employment or service as a fire fighter in 97 98 the manner provided in subsection (2) of this section, may be 99 issued a distinctive license tag decal for each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a fire fighter. 100 101 The distinctive license tag decal shall be of such size, color and 102 design as may be agreed upon by the Executive Committee of the 103 Mississippi Fire Fighters Association and the State Tax Commission; however, the State Tax Commission shall have final 104 105 approval of the size, color and design. The distinctive license tag decals shall be prepared and sold at Two Dollars (\$2.00) each 106 107 through the Mississippi Fire Fighters Training Academy; however, 108 volunteer fire fighters shall be exempt from the payment of such 109 fee.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
