## HOUSE BILL NO. 458

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-46, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 INCREASE THE FEE FOR REINSTATEMENT OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE SUSPENDED 2 3 OR REVOKED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI IMPLIED CONSENT LAW OR AS A RESULT OF A CONVICTION OF A VIOLATION OF THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES LAW; TO PROVIDE THAT MONIES COLLECTED FROM 4 5 б THE INCREASED FEE SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO A SPECIAL FUND IN THE 7 STATE TREASURY AND MAY BE EXPENDED ONLY TO PROVIDE SALARY 8 INCREASES FOR MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY SAFETY PATROL OFFICERS AND EXPENSES RELATED TO TRAINING OF NEW RECRUITS OF THE MISSISSIPPI 9 10 HIGHWAY SAFETY PATROL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 63-1-46, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

14 63-1-46. (1) A fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) shall be 15 charged for the reinstatement of a license issued pursuant to this 16 article to every person whose license has been validly suspended, 17 revoked or cancelled. This fee shall be in addition to the fee 18 provided for in Section 63-1-43.

19 (2) The funds received under the provisions of subsection
20 (1) of this section shall be deposited into the State General Fund
21 in accordance with Section 45-1-23.

22 (3) In addition to the fee provided for in subsection (1) of this section, an additional fee of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars 23 24 (\$250.00) shall be charged for the reinstatement of a license issued pursuant to this article to every person whose license has 25 26 been suspended or revoked under the provisions of the Mississippi 27 Implied Consent Law or as a result of a conviction of a violation of the Uniform Controlled Substances Law under the provisions of 28 Section 63-1-71. 29

30 (4) The funds received under the provisions of subsection
31 (3) of this section shall be placed in a special fund hereby

32 created in the State Treasury. Monies in such special fund may be 33 expended, upon appropriation by the Legislature, solely to provide

34 salary increases for Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol officers

35 and expenses related to training of new recruits of the

36 Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol.

37 (5) The procedure for the reinstatement of a license issued 38 pursuant to this article that has been suspended for being out of 39 compliance with an order for support, as defined in Section 40 93-11-153, and the payment of any fees for the reinstatement of a 41 license suspended for that purpose, shall be governed by Section 42 93-11-157 or 93-11-163, as the case may be.

43 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 and after July 1, 2006.
