HOUSE BILL NO. 534

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-13-405, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXTEND THE DATE OF THE REPEALER ON THE SECTION THAT ESTABLISHES THE HEALTH CARE TRUST FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 43-13-405, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 43-13-405. (1) In accordance with the purposes of this 9 article, there is established in the State Treasury the Health 10 Care Trust Fund, into which shall be deposited Two Hundred Eighty Million Dollars (\$280,000,000.00) of the funds received by the 11 State of Mississippi as a result of the tobacco settlement as of 12 the end of fiscal year 1999, and all tobacco settlement 13 installment payments made in subsequent years for which the use or 14 purpose for expenditure is not restricted by the terms of the 15 16 settlement, except as otherwise provided in Section 43-13-407(2) 17 and (3). All income from the investment of the funds in the Health Care Trust Fund shall be credited to the account of the 18 19 Health Care Trust Fund. The funds in the Health Care Trust Fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General 20 21 Fund.

(2) The Health Care Trust Fund shall remain inviolate and shall never be expended, except as provided in this article. The Legislature shall appropriate from the Health Care Trust Fund such sums as are necessary to recoup any funds lost as a result of any of the following actions:

27 (a) The federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid
28 Services, or other agency of the federal government, is successful
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29 in recouping tobacco settlement funds from the State of

30 Mississippi;

31 (b) The federal share of funds for the support of the 32 Mississippi Medicaid Program is reduced directly or indirectly as 33 a result of the tobacco settlement;

34 (c) Federal funding for any other program is reduced as35 a result of the tobacco settlement; or

36 (d) Tobacco cessation programs are mandated by the37 federal government or court order.

38 (3) This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2008.

39 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 40 and after July 1, 2006.
