HOUSE BILL NO. 653

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-41-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT FOR SCHOOL BUSES ON 2. 3 INTERSTATES AND CERTAIN HIGHWAYS WHILE ON AUTHORIZED TRIPS; AND 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 37-41-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 37-41-47. Except as otherwise provided in this section, it 8 9 shall be unlawful for a driver of any school bus, whether a public 10 or a contract bus, to drive the bus at a speed greater than forty-five (45) miles per hour while transporting children to and 11 from school on regular routes. * * * Any such driver, while 12 operating a school bus on other authorized trips, shall not drive 13 the school bus at a speed greater than fifty (50) miles per hour 14 on streets and highways having less than four (4) lanes or sixty 15 16 (60) miles per hour on portions of the Interstate Highway System and divided highways having four (4) or more lanes. However, if 17 the maximum speed limit posted on any street, highway or portion 18 19 of the Interstate Highway System is lower than the speed limit established for school buses under this section, the driver of a 20 school bus may not drive the bus at a speed greater than the 21 posted speed limit. Any person who shall violate the provisions 22 23 of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than Twenty-five 24 Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for 25 26 each such offense. In addition thereto, upon such conviction, such driver may be discharged from further employment as a school 2.7 28 bus driver or carrier, and his contract as such may be terminated. *HR07/R1097* H.
