6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. Section 27-7-91, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8	amended as follows:
9	27-7-91. (1) Each resident individual taxpayer who files a
LO	Mississippi income tax return and who will receive a tax refund
L1	from the State Tax Commission may designate that a contribution be
L2	made to the "Mississippi Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks Foundation"
L3	by marking the appropriate box printed on the return pursuant to
L4	this subsection. In the case of a joint return, each spouse may
L5	designate that a portion of the refund shall be paid to such fund.
L6	The State Tax Commission shall print on the Mississippi
L7	income tax form for residents a space for designating the
L8	contribution in substantially the following form:
L9	"MISSISSIPPI WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS FOUNDATION * * *

23	(2) The State Tax Commission shall explain in the
24	instructions accompanying the individual income tax form the
25	purposes for which the contributions authorized herein shall be
26	used.
27	(3) This section shall apply to taxable years beginning on
28	or after January 1, 2006.

29	SECTION 2.	Section	27-7-93,	Mississippi	Code	of	1972,	is

- 30 amended as follows:
- 31 27-7-93. (1) The Chairman of the State Tax Commission shall
- 32 determine annually the total amount designated by individuals to
- 33 be paid to the foundation, along with all interest earned thereon,
- 34 and shall report such amount to the State Treasurer who shall pay
- 35 such amount into the Mississippi Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks
- 36 Foundation.
- 37 (2) The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and
- 38 Parks may expend such monies deposited into the foundation
- 39 pursuant to subsection (1) of this section only to implement the
- 40 "Mississippi Natural Heritage Law of 1978," Sections 49-5-141
- 41 through 49-5-157, Mississippi Code of 1972, by providing for the
- 42 protection and management of nongame species, threatened or
- 43 endangered wildlife or plants, and unique geological formations
- 44 such as waterfalls, caves and canyons, and by purchasing, leasing,
- 45 registering, dedicating and maintaining natural areas.
- 46 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 47 and after its passage.
